

AGM 2018 – Constitutional Amendments

Amendment 1

Amend Section 9.3 by replacing 'the College' with 'ANUSA'.

Amendment 2

Amend Section 11.7 by inserting the word 'the Vice-President (Administration)' before 'and the Vice-President (Finance)'.

Amendment 3

Insert Section 18.5.5 under Section 18.5.4 reading:

upon a resolution approved by at least four-fifths of members present at a General Meeting.

Amendment 4

Insert Section 18.5.5.1 under Section 18.5.5 reading:

A motion to remove an office holder upon a resolution approved by at least four-fifths of members present at a General Meeting must be submitted to the Vice-President (Administration) at least seven (7) days before a scheduled General Meeting. The motion must be seconded and must state why the mover of the motion believes that the office holder is not adequately fulfilling their duties or is acting in a manner prejudicial to the Society which therefore warrants their removal.

Amendment 5

Insert Section 18.5.5.2 under Section 18.5.5.1 reading:

Notice of such a Meeting must be publicised to all members at least five (5) days before the meeting and must include notice of motion to remove that office holder.

Amendment 6

Insert Section 18.5.5.2.1 under Section 18.5.5.2 reading:

For the purposes of this section, notice must include an email sent directly to all Paid and Voting members, in addition to the requirements contained in section 21.5.

Amendment 7

Insert Section 18.5.5.3 under Section 18.5.5.2.1 reading:

The office holder has a right to speak on their own behalf at a General Meeting in defence of their removal.

Amendment 8

Amend Section 18.6 by replacing 'simple majority vote of the Committee' with 'vote of the Executive in accordance with clause 16.3.1'.

Amendment 9

Insert Section 20.3.1 under Section 20.3 reading:

Where there is a tie between candidates on first preference votes, second and third preference votes will be counted.

Amendment 10

Amend Section 20.6 by removing 'annual'.

Amendment 11

Insert Section 20.14.1 under Section 20.14 reading:

Notwithstanding clause 20.14, the exact numerical results of the election will only be released to candidates who contested that particular position at request from the Returning Officer.

Amendment 12

Insert Section 20.14.2 under Section 20.14.1 reading:

The Returning Officer may release the exact numerical results of the election at their discretion in an extenuating circumstance.

Amendment 13

Insert Section 20.15 under Section 20.14.2 reading:

In the unlikely event of a tie, the position will be filled by appointment by the Executive.
